

Emergency Closing/Snow Days

Listen to your radio (WTOP - 1500 AM) and check the television stations (Channels 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9) for details. Again, when Prince George's County Public Schools are closed for inclement weather, Dupont Park Adventist School will also close.

Before and Aftercare


